Every year, the Chautauqua County Workers' Memorial Committee sponsors this event. This year's event will be held on May 4, 2024. The event will start as usual at 11:00AM, Erlandson County Park in Frewsburg. This year's keynote speaker is Chuck DeAngelo, Labor Lawyer, and friend of Labor. On this day, we will be remembering "all Chautauqua County Workers" who have been injured or killed on the job in Chautauqua County. Erlandson County Park is the site of the Chautauqua County Workers Memorial and Gazebo. Dress warmly as Erlandson Park is one of the highest points in the County and is generally windy. Upwards to 10,000 visitors a year visit the Park, enjoying the scenic views, picnicking and hiking the nature trails at the park: one of the many outdoor recreational areas in Chautauqua County. The park is made possible by the cooperation of Chautauqua County Government, Parks Commission and the funds for the gazebo were obtained from a grant from our late Senator-Jess Present.

We would also like you to pass on a request of ours to either/or your town historian or your town clerk who are also invited. One of the things we do at the memorial is read the names of those workers who died while on their job in Chautauqua County. We try to get as many of these workers as possible.
